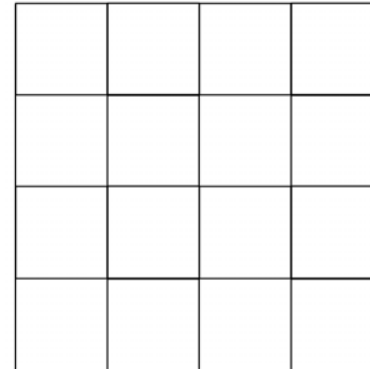
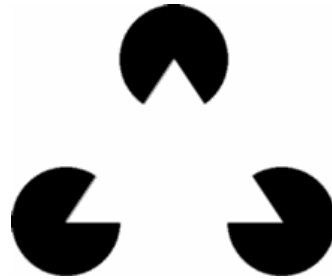

**Secret Surveillance:** Good secret agents have mastered the ability to see. After all, to spy is to observe. This may sound simple; however, the real trick in observation is to develop your ability to see clearly, accurately and with incredible detail. Check out your observation skills with these examples:

1. Do you see the triangle? Are you sure? Actually, it doesn't exist. It is an optical illusion. The angles of the three "pie-like" images give the appearance of a triangle.



4. How many squares do you see in this image?

**Answer:** 30 squares. Add them up: 16 little ones, 9 made of four little ones each, 4 made of nine little squares each and 1 big square made of sixteen little squares.

5. Can you read the hidden message below? **Answer:** "Do you see a black cat?" "No I see a sheep dog." Look at the image from the bottom edge of the page, then from the left edge.



2. What do you see in the middle of this image?  
Depending on how you associate the image, it can be either the number "13" or the letter "B".

3. Look at the top hat. Do you think it is taller or wider?

**Answer:** The hat is the same height and width.
